The School Improvement Steering Committee designs a yearly plan for school improvement. Our focus continues to be on student achievement in all areas. In FY2010, students achieved gains in Reading, Math, Writing and Science.

The School Improvement Steering Committee voted to use the School Improvement funds (Lottery dollars) for Advanced Placement training for teachers, Career and Technical Education Training, professional development, classroom equipment, activities to improve parental involvement which supported our efforts towards increases in student achievement.
