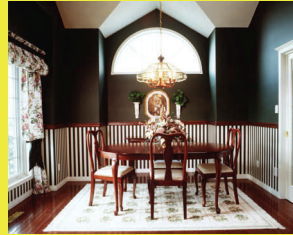


INTERIOR DECORATING 1

This course familiarizes students with techniques that enhance the esthetics of interiors, using colors, fabrics, finishes and furniture arrangement, window treatments and accessories.



Students will be introduced to the principles of basic interior decorating skills, which include:

1. Color theory and schemes
2. Fabric and Finish choice
3. Measuring for wall, floor and window treatments
4. Estimating materials and costs
5. Using the scale ruler
